We know that your privacy is very important to you. We recognise the importance of protecting the privacy of information that we may collect from online visitors. Compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 underlies all of our personal information privacy practices. We also have a Data Protection statement which governs how we use the information that we collect about you on this website.

Data Protection Statement

The CPAs data protection statement is as follows:

Data Protection Act 1998: By providing your personal details you agree to allow the CPA to contact you by mail, email, telephone or SMS text message in connection with its charitable purposes. The CPA does not make personal data available to external individuals or organisations.

How we collect information about you

The CPA does not capture and store any personal information about individuals who access this website, except where you choose to give us your personal information. These could include becoming a member, requesting resources, booking into an event, making a donation, or by sending us an email.

The CPA does not receive or hold any credit card details for donations/payments made via this website.

Why we collect information about you

To provide you with information about our work including membership related mailings, events, resources, fundraising and any other services described on our website.

To make sure we have an accurate record of all donations received.

To enhance or improve your experience on our website.

Who sees your information?

The information we collect through our website will be used exclusively within the Christian Police Association. We do not pass any of your personal information to any other organisations and/or individuals without your express consent with the following exceptions:

Name and address details may be passed to the regional CPA coordinator or Branch Leader in order to make contact with you concerning your membership requirements and/or resources you have requested.

The information that you provide to CPA will be used to provide you with information about our work including membership related mailings, events, resources, fundraising and other services and activities described on our website.

By providing information you are agreeing to receive mailings that communicate the work of the CPA.

By providing your email address you are agreeing to your email address being used for the purposes of receiving emails that communicate the work of the CPA.

[How long do we keep your information?](#)

How long we keep your information collected through our website depends on the context in which you provided it.

We will keep information that is necessary for us to provide membership mailings, other resources and for statistical purposes.

We will keep records of any financial transactions you enter into with us for a minimum of six years. This will enable us to meet with accounting requirements and respond to any questions from you that arise during that period. Gift Aid forms and transactions must be kept for a minimum of 12 years after the Gift Aid is no longer valid.
